

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING  
BETWEEN  
WALAILAK UNIVERSITY, THAILAND  
AND  
GADJAH MADA UNIVERSITY, INDONESIA




in the spirit of the agreement between the Thai and Indonesian Ministers of Foreign Affairs at the Fourth Meeting of the Joint Commission on Economic and Technical Cooperation between Thailand and Indonesia held on 14-15 June 2001 to set up Indonesian and Thai studies centres in the counterpart country to be supported by the governments of both countries. Walailak University and the Gadjah Mada University agree to enter into a formal exchange agreement based on the foundation of mutual trust for the mutual benefit and development of the two universities and the promotion of understanding and goodwill among ASEAN countries. The areas for cooperation are as follows:


1. The two universities agree to jointly develop some or all of the following activities based on their respective academic and educational needs
  - (i) Exchange of scholars and teaching staff
  - (ii) Exchange of students; especially "in-country" language learning
  - (iii) Facilitation of in-country work experience for students in Southeast Asian Studies
  - (iv) Establishment of a jointly taught Masters degree program in Southeast Asian Studies
  - (v) Organisation of joint research programs
  - (vi) Organisation of joint workshops and seminars
  - (vii) Exchange of research and teaching materials, publications and other relevant information
2. The two universities agree to establish a working party consisting of two representatives from each university to facilitate the implementation of the MOU
3. The implementation of exchange based on this agreement shall be separately negotiated and determined by both universities
4. Nothing shall diminish the full autonomy of either institution, nor will either upon the other in carrying out the agreement impose any constraints or financial obligations

5. This agreement is subject to revision by mutual agreement. It is also understood that either institution may terminate the agreement at any time, although such action will only be taken after mutual consultation in order to avoid any possible inconvenience to all parties.
6. This agreement is effective when the representatives of both universities have signed and dated the document.
